Land use is how land is used. There are different types of land use, including:

Residential- land used to create an area for people to live, such as house and flats.



Recreational- land used for leisure activities such as parks.



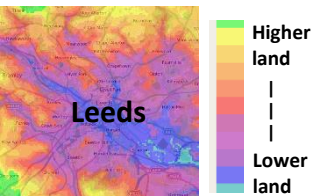
Commercial- land used for trade or businesses, such as warehouses and shops.



Transportation- land used to create ways for moving from place to place, such as railways and roads.



Agricultural- land used for farming.



Topography is the land features of a place, such as mountains, hills, rivers or valleys.

County- an area of land which include cities and towns.

Settlements: hamlet, village, town, city

The UK is divided into 92 different **counties**. In each of these, there are many **cities**. Leeds is a city in the county of West Yorkshire.

Geographical Skills and Fieldwork



How does the local area meet people's needs?

A survey is used to gather information. Questions can be asked to the public to find out information.

Gathering information – selecting appropriate questions to interview.

Sketching and Drawing the local area to see how land is used

Measuring – how to record your data. For example, using a tall chart to record the commercial land use.

Collecting Audio / Visual information – selecting from sources of information (pictures, maps) to select which ones best answer the question.

Representing information – how you present your findings to the class. You could use a presentation, a newspaper report.
